CHEQUES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORMS

The North Okanagan Holstein Club Spring Show will be held on **Saturday, April 11, 2015 at 8:30 A.M** in the Agriplex at the Armstrong Exhibition Grounds, Armstrong, BC.

ENTRIES:

- A. Entries should be made on entry forms provided.
- B. You only pay for entries of individual animals in classes 1 - 5 and 8-15.
- C. Regular entries close Friday, April 4, 2014.
- D. **Entry Fee per animal: \$15.00 before March 27th, \$25.00 March 28th –April 10th**
- E. Substitutes and added entries will be accepted until April 10th. **Excludes Super Cow.**
- F. DHIS records must be provided no later than 1 hour prior to the show for entrants in the super cow class.
- G. Failure to provide DHIS records for Super Cow will result in immediate disqualification from the class.
- H. Make cheques payable to the North Okanagan Holstein Club. **Entries will not be processed until a cheque is received.**
- I. A registered animal 75% pure and higher will be eligible to be shown.
- J. Failure to hang stall cards will result in forfeiture of prize money
- K. For North Okanagan Holstein Club Exhibitors only, failure to provide a minimum of 1 person for show clean- up on Monday April 13th may result in a forfeiture of prize money.

REGULATIONS:

- A. There is no limit to the number of head shown per exhibitor or per class by one exhibitor.
- B. PLEASE NOTICE: Registration papers must be in by noon April 10th 2015.
- C. Exhibitors are expected to present their exhibit in a desirable and attractive manner.
Please have Farm signs and Name cards (i.e. Name, Sire, Production etc.) above your display and maintain a tidy exhibit.
- D. Cattle may arrive after 9am Thursday, April 8th. Exhibitors are encouraged to have cattle in place by 10am Friday, April 10th.
- E. HEALTH: Any animal exhibiting evidence of infectious or contagious diseases, including: warts, ringworm, bangs, mange or other infectious skin conditions, may be refused entry and will be required to leave the grounds. THE DECISION OF THE VETERINARIAN SHALL BE FINAL.
- F. The North Okanagan Holstein Club & the Show Committee strongly encourage all exhibitors to have their animals tagged with the EZE-IR tags that meet the requirements of the National Livestock Identification Program.

2. Summer Yearling Born: June 01/14 - August 31/14
3. Junior Yearling Born: March 01/14 - May 31/14
4. Winter Yearling Born: December 01/13 - February 29/14
5. Senior Yearling Born: September 01/13 - November 30/14
6. Junior Group of three (see rules for breeder's herd)
No Entry Fee Required
7. Futurity: Animals entered in 2012, born in 2011
No Entry Fee Required
8. Junior 2 Year Old Born: March 01/13 - August 31/13
9. Senior 2 Year Old Born: September 01/12 - February 28/13
10. Junior 3 Year Old Born: March 01/12 - August 31/12
11. Senior 3 Year Old Born: September 01/11 - February 28/12
12. 4 Year Old Born: September 01/10 - August 31/11
13. 5 Year Old Born: September 01/09 - August 31/10
14. Mature Cow Born: Prior to September 01, 2009
15. Super Cow : Last DHIS record must be handed in to show clerks 1 hour prior to the show. To show in this class, you must enter by March 27th 2015. **NO SUBSTITUTIONS. NO LATE ENTRIES.**
16. Progeny of Dam: 2 Females from one dam which have competed in regular classes. **No Entry Fee Required**
17. Breeder's Herd: Group of THREE animals. All THREE bred by and at least TWO owned by the exhibitor. Each animal in the herd must have been exhibited in one of the classes for single animals. All 3 animals must carry the same prefix to be eligible for the group. **No Entry Fee Required**

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES FOR JUNIOR CHAMPIONS FOLLOWING CLASS #6, INTERMEDIATE CHAMPION COW WILL FOLLOW CLASS #11, and GRAND CHAMPION WILL FOLLOW CLASS #17.

SUPER COW WILL BE ANNOUNCED FOLLOWING THE GRAND CHAMPION CLASS.

PRIZE MONEY: First: \$40.00, Second:\$30.00, Third:\$20.00, Fourth:\$10.00

PREMIER BREEDER AND PREMIER EXHIBITOR POINTS: The nationally recommended point system for Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor will be used in 2015.

BEST BRED & OWNED: Best Bred & Owned in classes 1 thru 5 and 7 thru 14 will be recognized in each class. Animal must be bred by and owned partially or in whole by the same person, partnership, or company. Prize money: First- \$60.00, Second-\$40.00.

BEST OKANAGAN BRED AND OWNED: Best Okanagan Bred & Owned in classes 1 thru 5 and 7 thru 14 will be recognized in each class. Animal must be bred by and owned partially or in whole by the same person, partnership, or company. **OPEN TO OKANAGAN BREEDERS ONLY AND WILL BE AWARDED IN ADDITION TO THE BEST BRED & OWNED.**

BEST UDDER - The judge will designate the best udder in classes 7 through 13.

Each exhibitor will receive a class listing prior to the show. Changes and substitutions will be announced ringside.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- 1) Entry Fees must accompany your entries. We will no longer be deducting entry fees from prize money.**
- 2) Entries submitted after the March 27th deadline will be \$25.00**
- 3) Entries submitted/or substitutions made after the March 27th deadline may not be reflected in the show catalogue but will be announced ringside.**
- 4) Failure to hang stall cards may result in forfeiture of prize money**
- 5) In addition to Best Bred an owned, which is open to all exhibitors, the top Okanagan Bred and Owned will be presented with \$100.00 cash prize for classes 1-5 and 8-14. Okanagan bred and owned is for North Okanagan Holstein Club Members only.**
- 6) In order to qualify to be part of a junior or senior breeders group all animals must carry the same prefix.**
- 7) Exhibitors are responsible for their own hay and straw.**
- 8) Grain and Beet Pulp will be supplied by Sure Crop Feeds.**

All North Okanagan Holstein Club Members who Exhibit animals at the Spring Show are required to send at least one person to clean up on Monday, April 13th, 2015 (10:00am). Failure to do so may result in a forfeiture of prize money.
